ELECTIONS TO THE BOARD OF COVENTRY BEST FOR BUSINESS (CBFB)

Our report of voting for the above election which closed at 2pm on Tuesday 1st September 2009, is as follows:

Turnout:		21.2%
Number of votes found to be invalid:		5
Total number of valid votes to be counted:		544

Result (12 to elect)

There was a requirement to apply minimum constraints in terms of the categories represented by successful candidates, with the categories being as defined in the 2006 Business Plan of Coventry BID. Ultimately, the count was conducted without the constraints having any effect on the overall result.

The election was conducted using the single transferable vote electoral system.
